

# Cricket St Thomas Estate

In 1966 the Taylor family bought the estate which now has Warner's Hotel at its centre.

Swandown Lodges and the remainder of the Estate are owned and run by the Taylor family, who have created a number of walks over the 1,000 acres so that guests can appreciate the beautiful views and general enjoyment of the countryside.

The map marks the various routes, some long, others short, some require boots or stout walking shoes and others can be walked on the concrete and tarmac Estate roads.

The land is predominantly grassland, grazed for the production of lamb and beef, and woodlands are managed for forestry and game shooting from October to February.

Cricket St Thomas is a working Estate and there will be vehicles, tractors and heavy machinery moving about. Please take care and respect the countryside, leaving no litter, closing any gates and keeping dogs on leads.
